4 次の英文を読んで、以下の問いに答えなさい。

Tanya Pinto is the person who began Baal Dan, a US-based, *non-profit organization. Baal Dan is trying to help street children, slum children, and *orphans in India as directly and efficiently as possible, and the organization gives money to some *institutions to *provide an *education to these children.

In 2005, Tanya Pinto was a successful young businesswoman in Dallas, Texas in the U.S. But she decided to take three months off from work at an *advertising company to visit her birthplace, India. She volunteered at Mother Teresa's home for orphans in *Kolkata. She also traveled, and saw ① children in great need: they lived on the streets and they were asking for money, sleeping there, and searching *trash for things to play with.

② This experience was life changing for her and she decided to start a charity. She returned to her job in Texas and began Baal Dan Charities. In Hindi, Baal means "child" and Dan means "donation."

India has over eighteen million poor children. Some charity workers say the conditions on the streets are ア (bad) than those shown in *the film "Slumdog Millionaire." These children need to be helped by international charity projects like Baal Dan.

At first, Baal Dan gave street children clothes. Today, the organization gives money to *orphanages, schools and local projects. The money provides food, medicine, schoolbooks and some education. The work is centered in Kolkata, *Hyderabad and *Kerala province.

Tanya Pinto started her project with small donations from friends and *co-workers. She would pass them in the hallway and they would say, "Hey, when you go back to India next, here is twenty dollars, here is fifty dollars, here is ten dollars for the children." Today, Baal Dan has other *financial supporters in the United States. People organize events to get money. For example, a restaurant in Dallas *donates money every time people order ③ Tacos for a Cause."

In the next several years, Tanya Pinto hopes イ (begin) sponsoring an orphanage. She visits India as often as she can while working full-time at the advertising company. She says, ④ I will take the children on an outing. I will take them to the zoo or to the park. And so I'll do things that are really fun activities, because these are children who are living difficult lives and I like to bring some fun into their lives."

When she visited *a care center operated by a local group that her charity has helped, two boys *recognized her. They had met her at a shelter at a railway station the year before. The children were ウ (rescue) from the streets and were エ (do) well.

⑤ "Even if you are not a *celebrity, if you are not rich, if you are not famous, you can do something to help make this world a better place," Tanya says.
